- Confidence through creativity



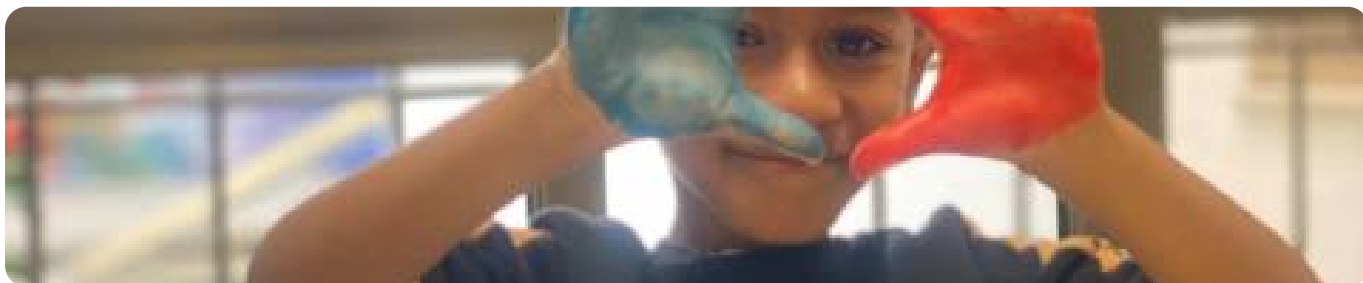
